Overview:

The SNAP-Ed Program has an opening for one full-time Nutrition Educator. Nutrition educators are responsible for conducting puppet shows and other nutrition education presentations.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Perform puppet shows primarily in public schools and early childhood centers, as well as present nutrition education at other community sites
- Carry, transport, assemble, and disassemble a portable puppet theater, equipment, and educational materials
- Prepare and distribute educational materials at all presentations
- Maintain adequate inventory of educational materials
- Schedule nutrition presentations
- Maintain records of daily activities on appropriate forms or database
- Provide input into program development
- Participate in other Hispanic Health Council activities, as needed and as time permits
- Other duties as assigned

- Valid CT driver's license and reliable transportation with insurance
- Willingness to travel from Hartford to the cities where the program services are provided
- Enthusiasm for nutrition, community work and working with children
- Good interpersonal and communication skills in individual and group context

- Able to lift up to 30 pounds
- Flexible to work on pre-scheduled weekends and/or evenings
